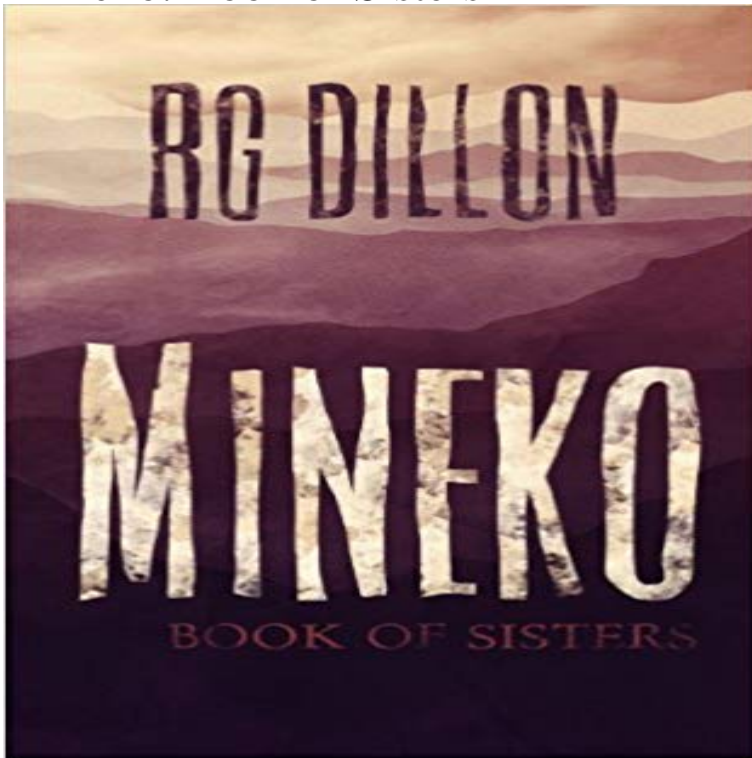


## Mineko: Book of Sisters
